The scavenger hunt begins at the Rose Garden and we have included a map that corresponds to the numbered locations below to help you find your way to the answers. Get to know Pacific!

(Students can find the answers to these 3 questions all over campus)

- What's the name of Pacific's newspaper? The Pacifican
- What's the name of Pacific's mascot? Powercat
- What are Pacific's school colors? Orange and Black

1. Marjorie Webster William Rose Garden and Robert E. Burns Tower

- Draw your favorite symbol from the mosaic of 1950.
- What do you see when you face East?
Burns Tower, Robert E. Burns was a man who started as a student (then became a professor, a dean) and eventually became the President of the school.
- How many stories/tall do you think it is?
9 stories tall, 256 feet
- What do you think is behind the stain glass windows?
150,000 gal water tank, was used once to supply half the campus with water.

2. Conservatory of Music

- What's your favorite instrument?
The Conservatory of Music is one of the most well-known schools at Pacific, you can learn to play TM instruments and be a part of the pep band. Our pep band plays at all of the Pacific basketball games and everyone is welcome to join!

3. Library

- What is the name of the Library?

William Knox Holt Library

- How many books do you think there are in the Library?
- more than 350,000
- *Feel free to take a tour to the bottom floor, then go left, to see actual writings and pictures of John Muir, the trophy from Amos Alonzo Stagg (who is one of the top 5 most winning coaches in college football), and sheet music from Dave Brubeck, a Pacific Alum, world renown Jazz pianist, and composer.*

4. The Talking Columns

- They are called the talking columns because if you stand in the center of the brass plate and face a column, your voice will echo, and nobody can hear it but you. Really!

5. McCaffrey Center

- What type of things do you like to do for fun?

Asuop, our student government, plans fun events that are free for students to attend. Dance floors, concerts, and Tiger Nights. Tiger Nights are once a semester and it varies every time, they have brought a mini Ferris wheel and snow to campus!

- What's your favorite movie?

If you like watching movies you're in luck because we have a theatre on campus! Our Janet Leigh theatre plays movies every weekend and they are movies that aren't out on DVD yet and it's free for students.

- What is your dream job?

At Pacific we have a Career Resource Center and they can help you reach your dream job by helping you get your first job and experience here at Pacific! But to get your dream job you need to do well in school and our Educational Resource Center can help you with that! They provide free tutoring for students.

6. Ted Baun Student Fitness Center

- Looking at the Baun Fitness Center (Gym). What do you think is behind the big window? 30ft Rock Climbing Wall (***Feel free to go inside and take a peek to see the wall***) But that is not all there is to do for fun through our fitness center. They have racquetball courts, backyard games like volleyball and soccer on Friday afternoons, recreational sports where you can make your own team and compete against others in sports like volleyball, soccer, dodge ball, flag football, basketball.

7. Don and Karen DeRosa University Center

- How many eateries are there in our De Rosa University Center?
3 Eateries, we have the *Marketplace, the River Room and The Lair* which is more like a *Buffalo Wild Wings* atmosphere. There is also a game room upstairs and a stage for karaoke and bands.
- What kind of materials do you guys recycle at home?

8. Student Life Tribute

10. House on Campus
